<u>ScotlandsPeople.gov.uk</u> (£)* The main (only) place to find Scottish birth, marriage and death records created by the government and churches. Also includes census records, Kirk Session records, tax records, wills, prison records, some employment records and Ordnance Survey name books.

<u>Old Scottish</u> - run by genealogist with index information from a range of sources in the National Records of Scotland (some the same as Scottish Indexes, some different)
